## **Notice of Temporary Service Interruption**

The Prince William County Service Authority regrets that it will be necessary to temporarily interrupt water service to your premises on, from approximately 8:00am to 5:00pm, on July 16, 2019, to allow water mains in your area to be worked on in order to improve water service. **The addresses affected are on 680 Watermans Drive**

If weather prevents this work on, we will reschedule, and a new service interruption notice will be supplied.

This temporary interruption of your water service will be kept as brief as possible, but we expect it to require at least 4-5 hours. Your understanding and cooperation in this matter are greatly appreciated.

We suggest that you:

- \* Fill containers with sufficient water for your cooking and drinking use during the indicated period.
- \* Shut the water to your hot water heater off.
- \* Keep toilet use during the outage to a minimum.
- \* When service resumes, open a cold-water tap and let the water run for several minutes, check for clarity.
- \* When water is clear, turn on the water to your hot water heater.
- \* Once the water is clear, you may do laundry.
- \* Wait at least 12 hours before using the water for tropical fish.
